Coach Malnerich is in his 15th season heading up the basketball program at St.

Benedict after finishing two years as an Assistant Coach at the University of Waterloo. Coach M is a Nationally Certified Level 3 Coach who has coached at the high school and OBA level for 24 years.

Coach Malnerich began coaching in 1993/94 at Widdifield Secondary School in North Bay where in five years he built an OFSAA contending program. In his last season, his team was 44 and 9, undefeated in league play, NOSSA Champions, and quarter-finalists at OFSAA, upsetting the 2nd seed in the first round.

Coach Malnerich's next stop was Timmins High and Vocational School where he had the challenge of taking over one of the best high school programs in Ontario (5 Provincial Championships, 4 Silver Medals and 12 final four appearances). Coach M didn't skip a beat helping the Senior Boys' Team accumulate a spectacular 148-33 record (0.818 winning %) over his four-year stay. His teams won tournaments all across Ontario and Quebec and finished with an amazing 50-7 record and the Antique Bronze Medal at OFSAA in his last year. Coach M helped guide the Blues to two other quarterfinal OFSAA appearances, the 1999 Reebok National High School Championship, four undefeated league seasons and four NEOAA Championships.

Since taking over the basketball program at St. Benedict, Coach Malnerich's teams have gained a reputation of being scrappy, determined, fundamentally sound and well prepared. Year in and year out they face a challenging schedule playing across Canada and the United States. They always play above expectations. The Saints have amassed a record of 253-57 (0.816 winning %) over the last 7 years and are never taken lightly by opponents. In 2016/17 they were repeat D8 Champions, CWOSAA Champions and won the Silver medal at OFSSA. This marked Coach M's third basketball program he has guided to qualify for an OFSAA Provincial Championship.

Coach M is known for developing players to play at their maximum potential. Over his high school coaching career, 28 of his players have gone on to play University and College basketball. He knows how to improve any aspect of your game-just ask!
