4.. Principal Report

- Covid Restrictions have relaxed
 - Starting on Monday April 4 increase capacity use in cafeteria, reduce down to 1 gym and hoping for nice weather to return when the students can enjoy the fresh air
 - Students should continue to do covid screening each day check fine print, always changing
 - Absenteeism is very low (less then 100 out of 1600 students)

- Mask are still encouraged but not mandatory any more, majority of staff still using them
- Upcoming dates:
 - o April 8 and June 3 ---- PA Days
 - May 10 ---- Asynchronous day, students at home except for the students writing the OSSLT
- Graduation/ Prom
 - o In-person Graduation ceremony is being planned at the Forward Church
 - Ceremony will be live streamed regardless in case of restrictions or for people not comfortable large crowds
 - Prices at Kitchener Aud has increased and in the past money has been lost due to cancellation, Forward Church has been very helpful and understanding with the situation and the planning
 - School has decided not to offer a Prom complications to where and who would be able to attend
 - Many venues require people to be fully vaccinated to attend which could exclude some students
 - Due to the uncertainty with where we will be in 2 months so focusing on Graduation was the priority
- Transportation challenges no progress today
- Next year planning has started, focusing on the de-streaming
- Not many interested for the Hybrid system
- E-Learning requirement for graduation 2 credits
- Hope to start offering Grade 11 courses on E-learning next year to help with this requirement
- Cafeteria Update let contract go due to Covid
 - Wasn't welling a lot, not much revenue to the school
 - There are conversations occurring to see what could be offered to students such as hot lunch days, vending machines. Tabling different options

 - Stated in the fall with 4 different groups
 - o 5 staff members are supporting the 4 different groups
 - o An additional mural was added to our walls, increasing our murals to 3 now
