GET INFORMED!

- Students decide what they want to pursue
- Find out who offers what (compare programs)
- ★ What courses and marks are required?
- ★ Consider your financial reality
- ★ Plan for best case scenarios; be sure to have a back-up plan in place

How to become an Apprentice. . .

- Must find an employer to sign you as an apprentice
- Register with Ministry of Training, Colleges, and Universities (Ministry of Advanced Education and Skill Development)
- Work (get paid), go to trade school and work through different levels
- Can take 2-4 years to become a Journeyperson



Every campus will have Counselling Services available to students.






