CFUW (Cambridge) awards scholarships of \$2000 each to three female students who are graduating from Cambridge, Ontario secondary schools. The selection criteria are as follows:

- demonstrate acceptance of an offer of enrolment in a post-secondary program
- enrolment in a Cambridge secondary school for at least three years
- academic achievement of over 80% in the final year of high school
- evidence of community involvement and participation in extra-curricular activities
- explanation of how the scholarship would be beneficial
